Eurasian watermilfoil

(Myriophyllum spicatum)

Invasive - present in Lake Tahoe

Key characteristic

• End of leaf typically flat



Leaves

- Feather-like
- 3-6 whorled leaves per node
- 13-25 leaflet pairs per leaf

Stem

- Collapses out of water
- Red or green in color

Roots

Shallow roots

Flowers

On elevated spikes, emerging above the water
